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ASPCA GRANT QUALIFICATIONS

IF YOU QUALIFY FOR THE GRANT, THE FEE FOR SPAY/NEUTER WILL BE \$10 PER PET.

The 2016 – 2017 ASPCA grant funds have all been allocated. No grant funds will be available until our 2017 – 2018 grant application is approved. You may still apply for the grant. If grant funds are not available at the time of your appointment, you will have the option of paying the balance or postponing the surgery.

The grant funds are made available to New York residents whose income is below the USDA Poverty Level. Full-time students, disabled veterans, and disability recipients may also qualify for the grant. Individuals and families with financial hardship, such as extreme medical bills, will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis. New York residents who adopt unaltered cats and dogs from 501(c)3 animal shelters may also qualify for grant funds. Applicants must provide financial documentation to verify income level and must sign a statement that they have disclosed all sources of income. Grant fund recipients must pay a \$10 co-pay plus \$7.50 each for rabies and DHPP or FVRCP vaccination unless they can provide proof of current status. According to our guidelines, all animals must have proof of vaccination or be made current at the spay/neuter clinic.

	You have an adoption contract from a municipal shelter or nonprofit (501c3) nal welfare organization in New York State.

Regardless of the above criteria, animals adopted from organizations whose adoption fees *include* the cost of spay/neuter services are NOT eligible for spay/neuter services through this program.
